| Academic Qualification | 10+2 with minimum score of 51% / Grade Point 6 / Grade C1 (CBSE) – Individually in each subject i.e. Physics / Mathematics / English Or A Higher Degree that includes these subjects with a minimum passing score of 51%. <i>Candidates must be fluent in English- written and verbal.</i> |
| Medical Qualification & BMI certificate | Candidates should be able to obtain and maintain DGCA Class 1 Medical Fitness Certificate with no limitations. Cadets must submit a BMI certificate (18–25 range) from a NABL-accredited hospital or lab. |
| Passport & Background Check | Must have a valid Indian passport with the ability to travel unrestricted worldwide. The candidates must also be able to produce a Criminal Record Check (CRC) Basic Disclosure Certificate, and pass all IndiGo and CAA reference checks. |
| Tattoos | Candidates with visible tattoos will not be considered |

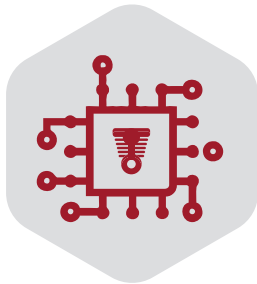
